The purpose of this evaluation report supplement is to indicate that FLAMEOFF FIRE BARRIER intumescent coating, recognized in ICC-ES master evaluation report ESR-3874, has also been evaluated for compliance with the codes noted below.

**2.0 CONCLUSIONS**

The FLAMEOFF FIRE BARRIER intumescent coating, described in Sections 2.0 through 7.0 of the master evaluation report ESR-3874, complies with the FBC, provided the design and installation are in accordance with the *International Building Code*® (IBC) provisions noted in the master report.

Use of the FLAMEOFF FIRE BARRIER intumescent coating for compliance with the High-Velocity Hurricane Zone provisions of the FBC has not been evaluated, and is outside the scope of this supplemental report.

For products falling under Florida Rule 9N-3, verification that the report holder's quality assurance program is audited by a quality assurance entity approved by the Florida Building Commission for the type of inspections being conducted is the responsibility of an approved validation entity (or the code official when the report holder does not possess an approval by the Commission).

This supplement expires concurrently with the master report, issued October 2016.
